Camp Prayers

"Addams Family Prayer" (to the tune of Addams Family theme song; cross arms in front of chest and snap fingers like the Addams Family.)

"Johnny Appleseed Prayer" (Make a big "o" with your arms above your head for the beginning, then clap along! At final "aaaamen," put arm(s) in air and swing down.)

Ohhhhh, the Lord is good to me and so I thank the Lord for giving me the things I need, the sun and the rain and the appleseed. The Lord is good to me. Amen (clap clap). Amen (clap clap). Amen amen amen. Aaaaaamen!

"Silent Prayer" Clap (to get everyone's attention); Point to where the food came from (like the kitchen or outside); Rub your belly (because you know it's going to be sooo good!); Give God a round of applause, and put your hands together at the end for the sing "Amen" (one hand in fist, other hand covers)
