6:35 - Called to order.

Opening Prayer – Pastor John shared a written devotional from the book "Devotions for Church Leaders and Small Groups", by Lynne Modranski. He would like to have each council member take a turn sharing a monthly devotional of their choice from the book. Patty will take the next meeting in August.

MOTION – by Joyce Etter, second by Ryan Jazdzewski, to approve the minutes from the May 16, 2023 meeting. – **Approved**

Pastors' Highlights;

Pastor John has had positive responses to his sermons he gave the first two weekends in June. "It's not just time to talk about what we should do, but begin doing." It was brought to his attention that we are stewards of our relationships. Everything we do as a church is stewardship. He would like to add the RIC ideas into our Stewardship campaign. He has had great coffee hour conversations and has heard stories from those around the table expressing how they have been affected by the struggles of the LGBTQ+ community. He is very excited for the future of Cross.

Major Ministries

RIC Discussion – We looked at Andy's outline of our next steps as a congregation. Joyce has
agreed to be the Mission Council member on the RIC Core Team. Pastor gave council members a
Faith Community Assessment questionnaire that he would like us to complete prior to the next
meeting. He shared information from the RIC website, (reconcilingworks.org), and synod resources. It is recommended that the resolution should take about six months. Andy will write a
letter for the newsletter to be approved by council before Carol publishes it. Andy will also give
several Mission Moments to explain, "What RIC is and what it isn't."

Minor Ministries

Pastor reminded council members to provide him with a photo to be placed on the bulletin board in the hallway.

• Stained Glass Windows – We reviewed the information John Oldenburg provided regarding the stained-glass windows. Council decided Building & Grounds should spearhead and organize the sale, with the suggestion that we have a silent auction. ½ of the windows will be offered to Cross members, the other ½ will be open to community and online sales. Claudia stated she believed the Hintz family donated the windows when they were first installed.

- **Nursing Room** Discussion was had on providing a nursing room for mothers. The old nursery room is ideal. The room will need blinds, a comfortable chair and updates to the sound system so the church service can be heard. Building & Grounds will be asked to be in charge of the purchase of the blinds and a chair. Pastor John will assist in updating the sound system.
- Veteran's Program Jim & Anita Mucci, Rachel Bennett and John Hakala presented a proposal for a veteran's thank you program to be held at Cross on November 5, 2023. The event will take place in Luther Hall and include a color guard, a luncheon, (funded by Thrivent Action Team), music, and recognition of each veteran. Council unanimously approved the idea.


